BEFORE ARRIVAL

- As an invitee, you have an ICBS account, which you can login using a link provided to you.
- Provide all requested information on your account ASAP. After July 5, we can't guarantee any updated information on your account will be acted upon. But we will do our best.
- Be sure to carefully go through the pre-arrival checklist on your account, and confirm the information there ASAP.
- As an invitee, your hotel will be booked for you free of charge, if we have your check in/out dates on your account.
- As an invitee, we can pick you up on your arrival at the airport/train station, if we have your arrival details on your account.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

At your arrival gate at PEK/PKX airport, please look for a dark-coloured 2025 ICBS sign. You will be guided to the shuttle bus by 2025 ICBS staffers. If you cannot find one, please call or email our 2025 ICBS Bus Team. If you take the train, we will arrange a vehicle to pick you up according to your arrival time. For departure from Beijing, look for the sign boards at your hotel lobby for airport/train station drop-off service during the conference period.

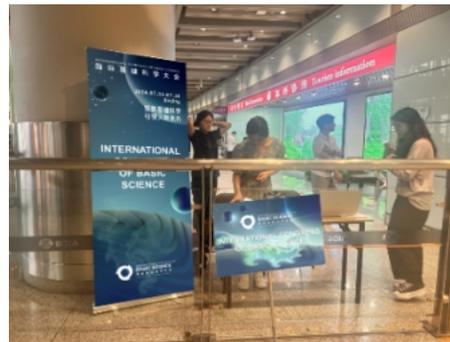

Shuttle bus schedule: The shuttle bus runs every two hours. The shuttle service time is from 00:00 on July 11 to 24:00 on July 13.

Pickup Point

Beijing Capital International (PEK) Airport: The pick-up point in Terminal 3 is outside Gate 9 on the first floor. The pick-up point in Terminal 2 is located at the temporary parking lot on the second floor.

Beijing Daxing International (PKX) Airport: The pick-up point for Daxing Airport is outside Gate 16 on the first floor. It is strongly recommended that you wait near the pick-up point while waiting for the pick-up vehicle. At that time, the specific pick-up point may change according to the actual situation. When the vehicle is about to arrive, volunteers will guide you to the pick-up point.

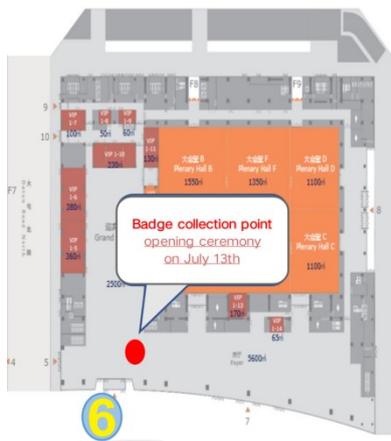

Dinner: Meals will be served from 17:30 to 19:00.

- (With food voucher) During the conference, dinner will be provided at BIMSA from July 14 to July 18 and from July 21 to July 25. No catering service will be provided on the 19th and 20th.

Internet Connection

WIFI: The venue of the congress and the hotel have free WIFI. You may need your own VPN apps to be able to access some sites outside of China.

At the CNCC, the WIFI network is "CNCC II free"; no password needed.

On BIMSA campus, available WIFI networks are "eduroam", and "ICBS2025", password: icbs2025

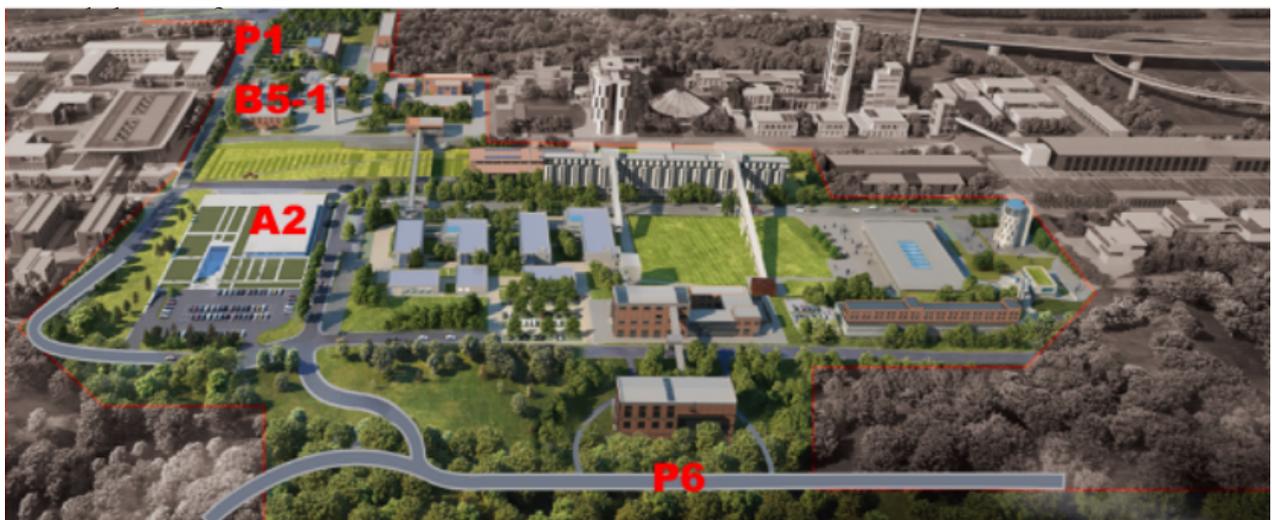
Venue Information

The BIMSA campus is the venue for most activities for July 14-25.

Parking

As shown in the attached picture, there is a parking space at P1. You can get your vehicle permit at the Certificate Service Center (B5-1) and drive from the staff driveway to the P6 parking area. However, the number of parking spaces is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis.

You can also park your vehicle at P1 and take the shuttle bus from B5-1 to A2 to

Transportation Arrangements and Routes

- Important guests, FSA award winners, UPA award winners and ICBS speakers can take the shuttle bus arranged by the organizing committee, depart from the

hotel and drop off at the East Plaza of the China National Convention Center Phase II, and enter the venue through Gate 6.

Public Transportation Recommendations

- Bus/Subway Travel: Use mobile map applications to query the route to the "National Convention Center Phase II". It is recommended to take the subway to "Olympic Park Station" Exit F and then walk to the destination.
- Taxi/Self-driving: Use navigation applications (such as Baidu Maps, AutoNavi Maps) to locate the "China National Convention Center Phase II". Taxis and self-driving vehicles should enter the underground parking lot from Ramp No. 2.

Parking Arrangements at the China National Convention Center Phase II

- Shuttle bus: Stop at the National Convention Center Phase II parking lot.
- Taxi: Drop off passengers at the intersection of Tianchen East Road and Datun North Road.
- Self-driving: Enter the underground parking lot at the China National Convention Center Phase II underground parking lot (Exit 2), park your vehicle according to the instructions, and be responsible for the relevant parking fees.



If you drive by yourself and do not have the conference badge, please go to Gate 6 of China National Convention Center Phase II to get the badge to enter the venue.

Entry Requirements

Entering the campus and venue requires participants to present their badge and undergo identity verification through security checks. Certain items such as beverages, lighters, weapons, sharp objects, explosive materials, and flammable substances are prohibited.

Dress Code

For the July 13 events at the CNCC, dark jacket and tie are recommended for men, business formal dress recommended for women. For remaining part of the the conference at BIMSA, business casual is recommended.

Meals

- July 13: The opening ceremony will be held at the CNCC Phase II building. Buffet lunch is provided. Refreshments are also provided during morning and

afternoon breaks. A banquet will be held at the CNCC the same evening, after the award ceremonies are over.

- During the conference period starting July 14 at BIMSA, refreshments are available during breaks. Buffet lunch is provided in the building A2 and A4. A meal coupon, given to participants at the time of check in, is required for lunch.

Other Requirements

Participants may bring mobile phones and are advised to bring their own power bank. The congress will provide medical assistance with a medical room and emergency ambulance available on-site.
