一、活动基本信息

二、乘车安排（13 日开幕式）

（一）VIP 嘉宾专属乘车

注意事项:

1. 在各酒店正门大巴车停靠点乘车;
2. 北京雁栖湖应用数学研究院停靠点在 A2 门口;
3. 请提前抵达, 凭注册凭证或参会证件乘车。

(三) 怀柔雁栖湖 P5 停车场集中发车

1. **集结时间:** 6:35 前抵达怀柔 P5 停车场。(数学院接驳班车请直接到 P5 停车场集结点落客, 换乘 14 号、15 号大会大巴车)

2. **发车时间:** 6:50 准时发车前往国家会议中心二期, 迟到需自行前往。

3. **落客点:** 国家会议中心二期大屯北路东口, 嘉宾经 6 号门安检进入会场。

4. **工作人员车辆:** 5:10 从数学院内 A2 门口集合登车直接前往国家会议中心二期。

三、停车区域规划及安排 (13 日)

(一) 国家会议中心指定停车区域

1. **西货场:** 停放大会指定接驳大巴车(交通组统一调度)。

2. **10号门VIP停车区**：仅限**10辆VIP车辆**停放（交通组统一调度）。

3. **东广场**：停放大会参会嘉宾车辆（交通组统一调度）。

4. **地下停车场**：自驾嘉宾车辆经**地下停车场2号出入口**进入，按指引停放。（无需车证）



（二）停车管理规范

1. 所有车辆须按指定区域停放。
2. 严禁占用消防通道、应急出入口及非停车区域。

四、停车后引导及安检流程

（一）志愿者引导

1. 停车场志愿者将引导嘉宾至2号电梯厅（沿途设指示牌）。

2. 乘电梯至一层后,前往6号门入口附近指定安检区域。

(二) 安检须知

1. 请携带注册凭证或参会文件配合检查。

2. 严禁携带违禁物品。

五、交通路线指引

(一) 公共交通

1. **地铁**: 乘坐至“奥林匹克公园站”F口出站,步行至东广场6号门(约8分钟)。

2. **公交**: 查询“国家会议中心二期”周边线路,建议使用百度地图/高德地图。

(二) 自驾/出租车

1. **持嘉宾车证车辆**: 导航至“国家会议中心二期东广场”。

2. **无车证车辆**: 导航至“国家会议中心地下停车场2号出入口”。

3. **出租车落客点**: 天辰东路与大屯北路交叉口。

4. **停车区域**: 持证车辆停东广场; 无证车辆停地下车库(2号口进入)。

六、重要注意事项

(一) 守时要求

大巴准时发车,逾时请自行前往。

(二) 证件必备

乘车/入场须出示注册凭证或参会证件。

七、数学院园区停车须知（13-25 日）


（一）院内老师入院请将车证放置在明显处以便安保辨识放行

- 1.数学院老师车辆停办公区 P6 停车场；
- 2.嘉宾持证车辆停园区 P3 停车场；
- 3.数学院老师电动自行车停原停车区域，禁停主干道及封控区。

（三）通用规则

禁占消防通道、应急口，请锁车并保管好个人物品，园区内限速（请查看限行标志）行驶，避让行人。

I. Congress Information

II. Shuttle Arrangements (July 13)

1. Exclusive VIP Shuttle Service

Reminders:

- Take buses at the main entrance of each hotel.
- BIMSA boarding point is at Gate A2.
- Please arrive early and present your registration proof or delegate pass when boarding.

3. Shuttle from Yanqi Lake P5 Parking Lot

- **Assembly Time:** Arrive at P5 by **6:35 AM**. (BIMSA Shuttles drop off directly at P5. And transfer to NO.14,15 Congress Bus)
- **Departure Time:** **6:50 AM sharp** to CNCC Phase II. Late arrivals must arrange their own transport.
- **Drop-off Point:** Intersection of Datun North Road, China National Convention Center Phase II. Guests enter through Gate 6 after security check.
- **Staff Shuttle:** Assemble at BIMSA Gate A2 at **5:10 AM**, depart directly to CNCC Phase II.

III. Parking Zones & Regulations (July 13)

1. Designated Parking at CNCC Phase II

- **West Cargo Area:** For official ICBS shuttle buses (managed by Transport Team).
- **Gate 10 VIP Zone:** Reserved for up to 10 VIP vehicles (managed by Transport Team).
- **East Plaza:** For delegate vehicles (managed by Transport Team).
- **Underground Garage:** For self-driving guests. Enter via Entrance 2. (No vehicle pass required.)



2. Parking Guidelines

- All vehicles must park in designated areas.
- Parking in fire lanes, emergency exits, or non-parking zones is strictly prohibited.

IV. Post-Parking Guidance & Security Check

1. Volunteer Assistance

- Volunteers at parking areas will guide guests to Elevator Lobby 2 (clearly marked with signage).
- Take the elevator to the first floor and proceed to the designated security check area near Gate 6.

2. Security Check Notes

- Please present your registration proof or delegate documents for inspection.
- Prohibited items are strictly forbidden.

V. Transportation Directions

1. Public Transportation

- **Subway:** Exit at *The Olympic Green station* (Exit F), then walk to Gate 6 of the East Plaza.(approx. 8 minutes)
- **Bus:** Search routes around “China National Convention Center Phase II” using Baidu or Amap (Gaode) Maps.

2. By Car or Taxi

- **Vehicles with Delegate Pass:** Navigate to “East Plaza, CNCC Phase II.”
- **Vehicles without Pass:** Navigate to “Underground Parking Entrance 2, CNCC Phase II.”
- **Taxi Drop-off:** Intersection of Tianchen East Road and Datun North Road.
- **Parking:** Vehicles with passes use the East Plaza; others use the underground garage via Entrance 2.

VI. Important Reminders

- **Punctuality:** Buses depart on time. Late arrivals must arrange their own transport.
- **Required Documents:** Boarding and venue entry require valid registration proof or delegate ID.

VII. Parking Guidelines at BIMSA Campus (July 13–25)

1. Campus Entry

- Faculty should display vehicle passes clearly for security clearance.

2. Parking Allocation

- **Faculty vehicles:** Park at Office Area P6 parking lot.
- **Authorized guest vehicles:** Park at Campus P3 parking lot.
- **Faculty e-bikes:** Use original parking zones. No parking on main roads or restricted areas.

3. General Rules

- Do not block fire lanes or emergency exits.
- Lock your vehicle and safeguard personal belongings.
- Obey speed limits and yield to pedestrians on campus roads.
